# **KMUN 2025 Code of Conduct**

## Professionalism and respect

- All delegates, chairs, and members of the secretariat are expected to maintain decorum and diplomacy throughout the conference.
- Respect towards fellow participants, organizers, and school staff is always mandatory.
- Discrimination, harassment, or bullying of any form-including based on race, gender, religion, sexuality, or nationality-will not be tolerated.

### Academic integrity

- Delegates must adhere to the spirit of Model UN debate, ensuring that all arguments, resolutions, and statements are authentic and well-researched.
- Plagiarism or falsification of data and sources is strictly prohibited.
- Delegates must use formal, diplomatic language and avoid offensive or inappropriate remarks.

### Punctuality and attendance

- Delegates must attend all committee sessions and arrive on time for roll call.
- Leaving a committee without permission from the Chair or Secretariat is not allowed.
- Delegates missing sessions will face disqualification from awards and will be denied access to the social.

### Dress Code

- Western Business Attire is compulsory for all participants.
- Delegates must ensure their attire is formal, modest, and appropriate for a diplomatic setting.

#### Committee Conduct

- Delegates must follow the Rules of Procedure (ROP) as directed by their committee chairs.
- Unparliamentary behavior such as shouting, disrespecting the dais, or disrupting debate will lead to official warnings or expulsion.
- The use of electronic devices during committee sessions is restricted to research and note-taking purposes only.

### Substance and Safety Policy

- Possession or consumption of alcohol, tobacco, or drugs is strictly forbidden on school premises or during conference hours.
- Any delegate found violating this rule will face immediate expulsion and their school and police will be notified. In addition, they will not be allowed to attend future KMUN events.
- Delegates must always maintain personal and peer safety, reporting any incident to the OC/EB/ Secretariat or teacher in-charge immediately.
- Delegates from Kanakia International School will be barred from attending all future events at Kanakia International school (including Relay for Life and Prom)

## Secretariat Authority

- The Secretariat's decision is final and binding in all matters, including disciplinary actions, award determinations, and procedural clarifications.
- Delegates are expected to cooperate fully with the Secretariat and staff to ensure the smooth functioning of the conference.
